This afternoon, Gov. Laura Kelly announced that all Kansas schools will be closed for the remainder of the 2019-20 school year to combat the spread of the coronavirus, or COVID-19, in our communities.

Now, with Gov. Kelly's decision, we can move forward to develop more concrete plans for how to handle the coming weeks. KSDE has convened a Continuous Learning Committee to develop a comprehensive plan to assist schools in delivering education to students while school buildings remain closed.

This is our plan moving forward:

- Next week, our staff will be transitioning their remaining classroom lessons to other forms of delivery which include Google Classroom, independent projects, and/or other online options for students.
- All the details will be shared with parents and students sometime next week on how the educational process will be carried out for the remainder of the semester.
- There will be several day's designated next week for students to come to school and pick up their books and personal items and clean out their lockers.
- Students in grades 10-12 all should have a chrome book. We will have Chrome books available for students in grades 7-9 to check out should the need one. We will share the checkout process next week.
- We will follow the school calendar as previously printed, but with no public events.

There are still many questions that we simply do not yet have answers for at this time.

With the state's guidance, and with the dedication, innovation and creativity of our staff and families here at SHHS, I am confident that the next few days will bring more clarity to many of these questions.
